PCC operates a 20,000 square foot building material reuse center called Philly Reclaim, which is located in Tacony (Northeast Philadelphia). Philly Reclaim sells doors, windows, mantel pieces, tiles, antiques, tools, paint, furniture, etc. Anything you could find in an old building! Recently, Philadelphia Community Corps also launched the Tacony Tool Library at Philly Reclaim, which is a community tool sharing resource.
